The Louisiana Department of Social Services in partnership with the LSU AgCenter's Family and Consumer Sciences staff are pleased to announce a **FREE child care business training opportunity!**

Beginning in 2007 through August 31, 2007, Child Care Business classes based on the First Step Fund's Child Care Business Curriculum Series will be offered in your area.

This 13-week series is available for potential and current child care directors and family day care providers living in or wishing to return to Cameron, Calcasieu, Jefferson, Orleans, St. Bernard, Plaquemines, Washington, and St. Tammany parishes and the surrounding areas.

This series is approved by the Department of Social Services for training hours and includes **research-based information to assist you in operating a quality child care program** in the state of Louisiana.

Topics will include: Budgeting, policy and procedure, legal issues, state licensing and staffing.

Child care business training is funded with Social Services block grant funds that were awarded to Louisiana to support the rebuilding efforts of child care following the devastation of hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

Pre-registration is required, and class size is limited to 30 participants per series! Please complete the registration form on the back and mail to the LSU AgCenter. We look forward to the opportunity of serving you.

Participants must commit to attend the entire series. Upon completion of the series, participants can receive up to \$2,500 worth of business resource materials and curriculum as well as a certificate of completion that will satisfy the DSS yearly training requirement.
